XII. Discussion of "Bear Aware" Funding From Colorado Parks and Wildlife/Direction to Staff

1. A member of the forest service reached out and contacted us to discuss a new grant opportunity that the Colorado Parks and Wildlife are putting together.
2. This program is giving the opportunity to come up with an innovative way to deal with problem bears in our community
3. We have talked about getting bear proof trash cans for the community through Monument Waste

4. We could look into bigger sized trash cans for the Town and place them at the rodeo grounds and or the parks
 - a. If we do get trash cans, we will be the ones paying for services and we will have to watch out because community members take advantage of that and use ours rather than theirs
5. Look into 3 sided fencing around the trash cans
6. At this point we really need to decide if we do have a problem or if this is just a seasonal thing
7. Lets engage our community and see if they feel we have a bear problem, give it some time and see if we can come up with some innovative ideas and see if they offer this again

XIII. Trustee (Informational and/or Items for Future Agenda)

1. Trustee Evans wanted to thank everyone, he appreciates all of the support throughout the years
2. Trustee Appelhanz said similar, thank you for the wonderful opportunity to be able to serve the community, was very much enjoyable
3. Trustee Dalrymple was looking through a CML Newsletter and read that there are bridge grants available and wondered if the bridge on Main Street would qualify
 - a. Don't think this would qualify being as the grants are for State Highways and they need to be below a certain structural rating
4. Trustee Melnikoff happy that the signs are up at the Auditorium for snow
5. Trustee Melnikoff asked where we were with fireworks
 - a. The fire department would not need to get certified as they found a lower quality firework that does not require that
 - b. If we get to the point where we can't do fireworks due to weather conditions we can store them and use them for the Cowboy Christmas
6. The Trustees decided to go forward with looking into fireworks with a budget of \$6,000.00 and asking the fire department to shoot them off
7. Administrator Matarozzo will talk to the fire department about this and bring it back to the Board

2. Administrator Matarozzo mentioned all of the events coming up- Easter Egg Hunt, Community Yard Sale

4. Mayor Todd was pleased with the Marshal's report, gives him a better idea of some of the topics
5. Administrator Matarozzo let everyone know that Marshal Appelhanz is going to have a trauma/med class April 23rd that is very beneficial
