

Town Tidbits

The Auditorium is one of the original structures to the Town of Collbran and has acted as a community centerpiece since 1911. In 2017 Mesa County added the building to the County Register of Historic Landmarks. The structure is unique with its arched truss design and mission style false front. The roof and side walls have been modified, primarily to address water infiltration issues.

The Town of Collbran has partnered with Colorado State Historic Fund, Colorado Department of Local Affairs, Colorado Development Block Grants Program and Mesa County to leverage our dollars to preserve and repair our history.

The first step in renovating the Auditorium is to remove the asbestos-containing materials using a specialized abatement firm. That process could start as early as March, and then the north and south exterior siding and roof will be replaced this summer. The historic front facade will be left as it currently is and with a fresh coat of paint.
